- I. "One and Done" Fundraiser - March 22-26, 2021
 - a. Publicity
 - i. Letter from PTO explaining "One and Done" to go in Tuesday Folder
 - ii. "Skate Night" style stickers to be sent home with students leading up to the event
 - b. Student Prizes
 - i. Each student who participates will receive a die cut Trojan. Trojans can be taped on teachers' doors or class bulletin boards with the name of the student. Ann has template and will send to PTO to cut out.
 - ii. Each class with 100% participation will receive an extra 30 min recess.
 - iii. Each student who donates \$10 will receive free ice cream ticket to be used on their class ice cream day. Have tickets from Fall Festival we can use.
 - iv. Each student who donates \$50 will receive cup and candy.
 - v. Each student who donates \$100 will receive water bottle.
 - vi. Each student who donates \$200 will receive t-shirt and can choose size and between 2 designs.
 - vii. Each grade level will have a class winner that will get a pizza party.
 - viii. Winning teacher will receive \$500 for classroom use; 2nd place teacher will receive \$250 for classroom use.
 - c. Logistics of Collecting Money/Giving Prizes
 - i. Teachers have an Infinite Campus Roster with names of their student in their class and columns for each category of prize
 - ii. Money to be collected daily or at the end of the week – TBD
 - iii. Deliver prizes after car riders in the morning
 - d. Celebration – Friday, 3/26, weather permitting
 - i. Ideas
 1. Obstacle Course – no equipment sharing due to Covid
 2. DJ – Freeze Dance
 3. No food – Covid restrictions
 4. Silly string, throwing pies, dunk tank?
 - ii. Each grade will participate during their connection times (50 minutes), but have to ensure they stay in their own pods
 - iii. Need 5 stations – Kindergarten and 5th grade have 5 classes, all others have 4
